### **Pastor's Pen- Sometimes Grace Surprises Me.**

**Acts 20:24** However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me – the task of testifying to the good news of God's grace.

Several times this month I've found myself saying "there's grace enough for that." And there is. Grace abounds. I think of grace as a verb. It's the mechanism of how God makes things happen in the world and in our

lives. God graced the creation into existence. God graces us with the right friend at the right time. God graced us with the son, Jesus. God graces us with \_\_\_\_\_ (fill in the blank).

God's grace sometimes surprises me, usually when I'm not paying adequate attention. It might be walking outside just as the sunset peaks. Or it might be having two children attempt to hug

me during the passing of the peace, choosing the exact same time to fly at me, nearly knocking me off my feet. Oh how I love when that happens! God has graced us with this community of faith, and St. John's has paid forward that grace in our community for two hundred years.

Our leadership council has been reflecting on where God is calling us to next. What will the next fifty years look like? Part of that reflection has resulted in our thinking about how the Miamisburg Schools (for one example) has been graced by the



donations of school supplies we deliver every year. We can even see the grace and gratitude on the faces of those we feed every month at our SonRise breakfast. I heard one man say, "Wow, we get cereal AND French toast, and NOW we get sausage, eggs, hash browns, AND even a banana!" Truly we make a difference in each other's lives and in the lives of our community when we share God's grace in the many ways we share it! It makes me think that GRACE is, well, CONTAGIOUS! Once we "catch it" we give it to others.

One of the things I love most about the ELCA is how we declare that there is grace enough for us to be unified in Christ while not always believing the exact same things. There is grace enough for difference. There is grace enough for different expressions of faith. Each of you graces me daily with your faith, your friendships, and your passion for God's people. I look forward to seeing how God's grace will continue to be witnessed to and shared by each of us.

#### **Caramel Popcorn**

20 cups popped popcorn 2 cups light brown sugar 1 cup margarine ½ cup light Karo syrup
1 tsp. salt
½ tsp. baking soda

Combine brown sugar, margarine, Karo syrup and salt. Bring to a boil for 5 minutes on medium heat, stirring constantly. Stir in ½ tsp. baking soda. Put popped popcorn in large roasting pan. Pour sugar mixture over popcorn. Bake at 250° for 1 hour, stirring every 15 minutes. Pour out onto cookie sheet and break apart. But given the millions of individuals and families touched by crime and incarceration in America and the complexities of our criminal justice system, how can followers of Jesus pursue justice that restores?

#### A CLARIFYING NOTE FROM BISHOP SUZANNE DILLAHUNT

The recent vote by the ELCA to become a Sanctuary Denomination has caused a flurry of questions, debate, interest, comments, criticism, anger and rejoicing in social and news media, from members, and concerned friends from across the country. On August 7, the Assembly adopted a resolution that, among other things, declared the ELCA to be "a sanctuary church body". We received questions and comments as well, some in support of the action and some against. There is a lot of misinformation swirling around and I want to invite you to stop and breathe, creating space to look at and absorb exactly what all of this means. It is important to look at the materials and the resolution itself. So as we breathe together and ask the Lutheran Question: 'What does this mean?' keep in mind the following:

- The Churchwide Assembly's declaration as a sanctuary denomination binds ONLY the ELCA Churchwide Organization; it does NOT bind congregations, synods or other organizations.
- Furthermore, the resolution passed this past week affirmed "the long-term and growing commitment of this church to migrants and refugees and to the policy questions involved". Declaring the ELCA to be a sanctuary church body is a public declaration that we will continue doing what we have been doing as a church for a long time in support of refugees and immigrants.
- The Churchwide Assembly did NOT define what it means to be a sanctuary denomination, but rather requested that the ELCA Church Council provide guidance as to what it means to be a sanctuary
- The Churchwide Assembly (and this is important) did NOT call for any illegal actions. All actions mentioned by the assembly are legal, and whether any person or organization chooses to engage in civil disobedience and accept the consequences is up to them.
- I repeat, NOTHING in this action binds synods, congregations or any other organizations affiliated with the ELCA...It binds Churchwide and Churchwide alone. And the question of what does this mean and how we live into this is the Church Council's work. We have to expect people to interpret the declaration in many ways.
- What can you do? Keep breathing and do some homework...
- Review the **resolution as reported** in the Assembly's Legislative Update (See ELCA website)
- Take a look at and re-read the <u>ELCA Social Teaching Statement on Immigration</u> which helps provide the context and history that informed the decision
- Review the 2018 SOS Resolution on the Separation of children from parents which, we as a synod, passed: <u>2018 SOS Assembly Resolution</u>
- FAQs from the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU): <u>ACLU Sanctuary Congregations and Harboring</u>
