Dear Siblings in Christ,

December 1, 2021

Well, what a difference a year makes. Last December, I sadly and very reluctantly announced that Christmas Eve would be a virtual service. Thankfully, we are very excited to return to our traditional Christmas Service roots and will have a fabulous **in-person Christmas Eve Vigil Service at 8:00 PM on Friday December 24, 2021!** I am so grateful to be back in our Sanctuary during Advent and Christmas, and I hope our service will be another big community event. For starters, we will again host Veronika Stanichar, an extremely talented high school harpist who is concurrently studying at the University of Cincinnati School of Music. *Plan to be in church at least 15-20 minutes early to hear her extended Christmas prelude*, and she will accompany us on several songs. Of course, Christmas is likely Doug McCabe's favorite season, so his great talents will lead us through many of our favorite hymn traditions. Invite your family and friends, and get excited about attending our service to welcome the newly born Lord Jesus into our collective families! For those who cannot attend in person, we'll have the service simulcast so you can be with us that evening. The website (www.stjohnsmiamisburg.org) always has the simulcast zoom link. In the event you are travelling, I'll be sure to post the service so you can watch at your leisure.

After Christmas, we need to lay out what the next few months looks like for our Congregation. We will have in person worship on Sunday morning December 26th, at the usual 10:00 AM, and this service, as always, will also be simulcast. As we move into January, it will be time to plan for our annual congregation meeting on Sunday, January 23rd, so mark that date. Planning for 2022 budget will be a bit of a guessing game regarding income and expenses because we have an active call request and we don't know when a candidate may emerge. We'll plan on a supply or new interim for at least 6 months, and hopefully will close in on a candidate by the second half of 2022. Once Council looks at and approves this draft 2022 budget, the congregation will vote on it on January 23, 2022 in an in-person Congregational meeting after church service. (We will simulcast this right after service as well, so people can still participate in the Annual Meeting even if they are not at church.) Part of this meeting will be devoted to replacing our one council members rotating off (Don Pabst – *THANK YOU for your service these last 2 years!*)
