Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

January 1st, 2022

Happy New Year of our Lord 2022! Let us all work for peace, show kindness and hope, and do whatever we can to help our community to know and see God's Love in practice in our outreach and service. We also pray for an abatement of this pandemic and a return to some normalcy in our everyday lives.

I wanted to send this quick note to the Congregation to let you know we will be implementing some changes in our Sunday Service starting tomorrow due to the extraordinary surge in Ohio's COVID19 caseload and positivity rate. When we reopened to in-person worship, the weekly case numbers had fallen close to 2,200 per day for the entire state. We are now seeing infection rates as high as 24,000 per week, a nearly 10 fold increase.

As a result of these trends, we are reverting back to the "common communion table" instead of traditional communion. Also, we will <u>encourage (but not require) masks for service</u>. Finally, if you believe you are particularly vulnerable whether you're vaccinated or not, and want to be safe, you can <u>always</u> join us on-line for our simulcast using the following link.

Lastly, you may have heard that the US is seeing more "breakthrough" cases of COVID with fully vaccinated (and boosted) individuals. My youngest sister Eileen suffered through a breakthrough case over the holidays. However, the overall COVID19 mortality statistics are still very telling. **94+% of serious COVID cases and deaths are still occurring amongst** *unvaccinated individuals*. While vaccines are always a personal choice between individuals and their Doctors, as President of the Congregation I urge those who have hesitated on the vaccination to call your Dr's office and speak to a Nurse Practitioner or schedule an appointment if you are still not sure about taking the shot. We love all our Congregants, we certainly don't want anyone to suffer or pass on when a viable alternative provided by God's hands through our researchers and Doctors is right within our personal grasp. Please pray about this choice!

Miamisburg Helping Hands really appreciates your very generous donation of \$1152.00 that we recently received from you. So far in 2021 we have served 1575 households and 4742 individuals.

When clients visit the pantry, we give an average family 50 lbs. of food (more to larger families) plus bread, milk, eggs, meat and fresh produce when it is available. With your donation we will be able to purchase 6336 lb. of food from the Foodbank. Sometimes, we need to go to local grocers for some items when supplies run short and we shop for the best price.

We applaud your generosity and are very grateful, especially since there are those in our community unable to provide food for their families. Thank you for being such a loyal donor!

This recipe was submitted by Nancy McCabe from the "Kitchen Keepsakes from St. John's Family" cookbook that was published in 1998 by the Women of St. John's Lutheran Church.

White Chicken Chili

1 lb. dried great northern
 White beans
 2 lbs. boneless chicken breasts
 6 cups chicken broth
 1 tsp. marjoram
 1 ½ tsp. oregano

5 T. oil 1 T. green chili peppers

2 medium onions, chopped 1/2 tsp. cayenne pepper 3 cloves garlic, minced 3 cups white cheddar cheese

Place beans in a large pot and soak overnight in 3 inches of water.

Heat 3 tablespoons of oil in large pot. Chop chicken breasts and add to oil. Sauté for 5 minutes. Remove to a dish and reserve. Add remaining oil to pot. Stir in chopped onion, garlic, chili peppers and spices. Sauté for 5 minutes. Add drained beans and broth and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer about 2 hours until the beans are very tender. Add chicken and 1 cup cheese. Stir until cheese melts. Season with salt and pepper.

Serve with the following garnishes: sour cream, salsa and the remaining 2 cups of
