PRESIDENT'S CHAPEL

Dear Siblings in Christ,

Sep 1st, 2023

Compared to last month, this column is really going in a different direction....or is it? Last month I spoke of praying, perhaps this month we should start with "prayers answered"? After nearly 3 years, St Johns is now in serious negotiations on a potential new call. First, to moderate expectations, we are in the earliest stages of interviews and discussion. The candidate is also talking to 2 other local churches, and has not come to a conclusion on where he will end up. Yet our discussions with the call committee and council this past week were very good, and council is in the earliest stages of working on a compensation package. Will these negotiations end up with a call? It's not a guarantee, but it is our goal to negotiate with the candidate in good faith to that end. On that topic, the candidate has expressed a desire for a 60% call, slightly more than the 50% call we advertised. Council doesn't think this is a "deal breaker" by any means, but it will require each and every family of this Congregation to consider the following question. Are we ready for a call? Are we prepared to "step up" and contribute 10-15% more to our "current expenses" contributions to support the call? Because the truth is, if we want a permanent pastor after all this time, we can't extend this call and expect to pay for it without increasing our current contribution levels. Now this church has had a long history of coming through when financial needs present themselves. We've paid for renovations, roof leaks, HVAC systems often in quick and generous response times. Now is the time to consider that "next step" in giving. Once we work the compensation details, we will be able to tell you precisely what that call will translate to in increased congregational giving. Until we precisely know this number, I pray that you earnestly consider what you might be able to do to help support a new and permanent Pastor for St Johns.

Cranberry Bars

1 ½ cup oats½ cups chopped nuts1 ½ cup flour1 ½ stick margarine

½ tsp. salt 1 tbsp. water

34 cup brown sugar 1 can whole cranberry sauce

Mix oats, flour, salt, sugar and nuts. Stir in melted margarine. Press 2 ½ cups of mixture in a foil-lined 8-inch baking dish, let foil extend over edges. Bake 10 minutes at 375°. Add water to rest of mixture and stir. Stir sauce in can then spread over baked mixture and top with rest of mixture. Bake 35-40 minutes at 375°. Cool in pan, lift out with foil and cut into squares.
