To Christians in a time of deep political divides:

I'm writing this about one week before the presidential election. I don't know who will win. Some of you may read this before the election, but I'm primarily writing to us post-election. For pre-election, I can only say – take a step back and think. Don't be swayed by the pervasive emotional appeals of dubious factuality. Do your own fact checking. Partisan sources do not count. Ask what Jesus would do. In Luther's words be "Little Christs".

Now – on to the main task at hand. The election is over. Not knowing who wins, I can still assert that more than half the country is deeply unhappy (many don't like either main party candidate!). We have been conditioned to believe that, if the other side (for both sides) wins, that the worst possible future will ensue. While I do believe this election comes with high stakes, I also believe that we need to step back from this emotional manipulation and take a deep breath.

Fear-based motivation has, unfortunately, been shown to bring in the votes. It does so by dividing neighbor against neighbor. Whatever side wins, we will be left with strong feelings against a large portion of our country. As Christians, we are not about fear (Luke 12:32). God wins (I Cor. 15:57). We have hope because of the work of God (Jer. 29:11). Yet, God's plan includes the dark of crucifixion as a necessary piece of the gospel or resurrection (I Peter 5:10). We are in dark, divided days. Please – be a voice of peacemaking (Matt 5:9). Reach out to find common ground with neighbors (II Cor 5:18-19). Despite the rhetoric, both sides want what's best for our country (as they see it). Find common ground in love (I Peter 4:8). Find common ground in recognizing that we ultimately aren't in control, God is (Isa. 14:24). Find common ground in recognizing our need for reconciliation (Rom 3:23). Our country has emotionally ripped itself apart in this election cycle. It needs us. It needs the voice of love, reconciliation, and hope, that is the Gospel. Love your neighbors – especially THAT neighbor and pray for peace. Our work is just beginning.
