Jesus went on with his disciples to the villages of Caesarea Philippi; and on the way he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" And they answered him, "John the Baptist; and others, Elijah; and still others, one of the prophets." He asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered him, "You are the Messiah." – Mark 8:27-29

Who are you?

Above, we watch the disciples wrestle with the question of who Jesus is. Peter gets it "right" but goes on to show that he really doesn't get it – he objects to the crucifixion. We too wrestle with who Jesus is, but also – who are we?

I work with teenagers in my capacity as a soccer coach. In this stage of life, teens are actively "trying on" identities, trying to figure out who they are. I am... a soccer player, a popular person, a smart person, a book worm, class clown, clueless, a future doctor, trailer trash... etc.

As we age, we get another level of this question. Who am I ... now? I used to be able to.... But now I can only.... Who am I? My spouse has passed, who am I now? My kids don't need me (at least in the same way).. who am I now?

It would seem that these two questions – "Who is Jesus?", and "Who are we?" are actually closely related. Jesus is the Messiah – the son of the living God. He is our savior through the work of dying on a cross and rising again. Therefore, we can answer the second question - who are we? We are Jesus's!


