I'd like to share with you one of my favorite bible stories: Luke 24:13-35. It was a confusing time. Jesus had been arrested and killed. The hopes and dreams of the disciples and other followers of Jesus seemed to also have been killed. Yet, when all hope seemed lost, rumors started circulating. Jesus rose from the dead! Yet, people don't rise from the dead. Yet, an awful lot of people are saying they've seen and heard proof. Do we dare hope again?

A group on a journey to Emmaus shares their consternation. They walk alongside a stranger. This stranger seems to believe that, not only is Jesus risen from the dead, but that this fulfilled scripture and that Jesus is the Christ. It's nice to be around hopeful people, even if this group couldn't quite get themselves there.

After arriving and inviting the stranger to join them for dinner, he breaks the bread and all recognize him as Jesus. Then --- he disappears; They believe! They are off and running all the way back to where they started. Hope arrived, and in the breaking of the bread no less.

I love this story because it so often captures my journey. I'm walking through life. I'm pondering life, the universe and everything, and I'm wonder about God. And – often in hindsight – it hits me that Jesus has been present, leading and teaching me this whole time. This hindsight happens, often at least, when I slow down and focus on God. I share communion; God is present. The variable isn't God's presence, but whether I'm focused on it. Even when I'm not – which is all too often, God can and does break through, reminding us of Christ's presence always.

In our life together as church, this is a great passage too. We never know where we are going in life, not really. And Christ is beside us, teaching and leading us. As church, our challenge is to be ready for those moments. We do best when we don't assume we know where we are going or how the future will look. We do best when we're listening and ready
