January 2026 saw a 24-hour snowfall that exceeded the 24-hour snowfall of the blizzard of '78! The aftermath hasn't been nearly as bad, but still... snow! Lots and lots of snow! At the time of this writing (about a week after the snowstorm), people are already sick of winter and yearning for Spring. So, here's some thoughts inspired by living in a northern climate for a lot of years.

The long, cold winter gives way to spring, albeit reluctantly. When it does, Spring is more potent. Time outside is again seen as the gift it is. Verdant greens, birdsong, and other "spring things" just hit harder after a period long, dark cold. It means Lent will start, appropriately enough, in the midst of true winter. This is our long, dark spiritual time. It leads us toward introspection, and to our need for redemption in Christ. Easter will arrive as Spring looks to truly pop. Let this timing help you to feel the resurrection rhythms inherent in the seasons: The death of winter leads to new life in spring. Christ's death and resurrection allow us to see our whole life in this way: anticipating resurrection.

Spring hits better in other ways too. The bugs will have been truly winter-killed, leading to less biting pests. Poison ivy roots die out, shrinking that crop... colds, viruses etc. are lessened. This spring we anticipate better quality of life happening too. We are reminded that this also (metaphorically) is part of Christ's mission "I have come that you may have life and have it abundantly" (John 10:10).

So - stay warm. Stay hopeful. Our gratitude and wellbeing will soar this Spring as we look forward to hearing again the good news of Easter.

During Lent, Pastor will be leading "Honoring Our Neighbors Faith" on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 p.m. Sign up to bring a snack.

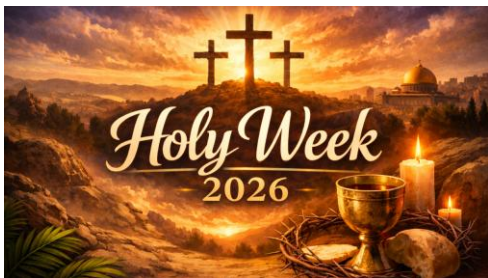
TWO UPCOMING GAME NIGHTS

NEW TAX BREAK FOR CHARITABLE CASH DONATIONS

There is a new tax law change that benefits those who do not itemize deductions on their tax return. Beginning this year, you can deduct cash donations to charities up to \$1,000 per single filer or \$2,000 per joint return when you do your taxes at the end of the year. This deduction is a credit subtracted from your taxable income, no need to itemize. If you would like credit for your cash donations and do not have a box of giving envelopes, call Judy Kuemmel (937-321-1198) or write your name on the envelope containing your cash donation. If you donate by check your name and address printed on the check will be used. A giving statement will be prepared for you at the end of the year showing your total donations. Why not maximize your generosity and get a tax credit too?
